Event Information for Students, Parents & Heads of Sport

Monday 24 August 2026 | Cottesloe Golf Club & Lake Claremont Golf

IGSSA WA Golf is back in 2026, held on the Monday of the Term 3 mid-term break. Thanks to the support of **Cottesloe Golf Club** and **Lake Claremont Par 3 Golf Course**, we're running two competitions on the day - one for experienced players and one for girls who are newer to the game.

Nominations are open now. Read below to find out which competition suits you, then sign up using the link below.

Who can enter	Students from all IGSSA member schools
Venues	Cottesloe Golf Club (18-hole) and Lake Claremont Golf Course (9-hole Ambrose)
Tee off	From 7:45am (18-hole) · from 10.00am (9-hole Ambrose)
Finish	Approximately 1.30pm, after lunch and presentations at Cottesloe Golf Club
Cost	\$50 (18-hole) · \$40 (9-hole Ambrose)
Nominations close	Friday 14 August 2026

Which competition should I enter?

There are two competitions running on the day. Choose the one that matches your experience.

	18-Hole Competition	9-Hole Team Ambrose
Who it's for	Students who have a Golflink number and handicap, and are comfortable playing the full game.	Girls newer to golf, still developing, without a handicap, or not yet comfortable with 18 holes.
Format	Combined Stroke / Stableford (for players with a GA handicap under 18). Stableford only (for players with a GA handicap over 18).	Team Ambrose, 9 holes, social. Teams are organised by IGSSA (you don't need to find your own).
Venue	Cottesloe Golf Club	Lake Claremont Golf Course (Bus transport provided by IGSSA to Cottesloe for lunch at conclusion of play)
Tee off	From 7:45am	From 10.00am
Cost	\$50 This includes competition fee, green fee and lunch. (Cottesloe Golf Club members pay competition and lunch fee only.)	\$40 This includes green fee and lunch.

A note on the 9-Hole Ambrose

This competition is designed for girls who are **still developing** but it is **not suitable for complete beginners**. You should already be familiar with swinging a golf club, whether through lessons, the driving range, or somewhere like X-Golf.

You do **not** need to know the rules or golf etiquette. A leader will guide your group on the day, and IGSSA will organise the teams for you.

- Once nominations close, detailed timings will be sent to all participants.

Cost & payment

18-Hole Competition	\$50: competition fee, green fee and lunch. Cottesloe Golf Club members pay the competition and lunch fee only.
9-Hole Ambrose	\$40: green fee and lunch.
How to pay	Your school will pay the green fee, competition fee and lunch up front, and will invoice families after the event. You do not need to pay anything on the day.

What the day looks like

Time	What's happening
From 8.00am	18-hole competition tees off at Cottesloe Golf Club.
From 10.00am	9-hole Team Ambrose tees off at Lake Claremont Golf Course
Late morning	Ambrose players finish their round and are transported to Cottesloe Golf Club via bus.
~12.30pm	Lunch at Cottesloe Golf Club for all participants.
~1.30pm	Presentations, then finish.

Detailed tee times and group allocations will be sent to all participants once nominations close.

What to bring

- **Your own clubs**
 - Ambrose players are able to hire a set of clubs from Lake Claremont – please contact nigel@golforacle.com.au to arrange in advance
- Golf shoes or flat-soled shoes (no spikes on the clubhouse floors).
- School sports uniform or appropriate golf attire (check your school's expectation).
- Hat, sunscreen and a water bottle. There is limited shade on course.
- Wet weather gear if rain is forecast.

- 18-hole players: bring your **Golfink number** — you'll need it for the competition.
